Military Housing Guidance States: Resident may provide in-home child care ONLY through participation in the Child Development Homes program. Resident must be certified through the Navy sponsored Child Development Program if child care is conducted in the Premises for more than 10 cumulative hours per week (i.e., Resident cares for three children for four hours is 12 hours of child care). Resident must also comply with all applicable state and local laws regarding child care. Conducting an unauthorized child care business shall result in an immediate cease of operations and may also result in eviction.
