## ELIGIBILITY

- Facility use will be in accordance with applicable Navy and DoD Regulations.
- All DoD ID card holders are eligible to use the pool. All other persons are considered guests.

#### **HEALTH PRECAUTIONS**

- Everyone must shower before entering the pool.
- Anyone with open sores, skin disease, and obvious evidence of a cold or any communicable illness will not be allowed in the pool water.
- Littering is not permitted. Trash and recyclable items must be placed in an appropriate receptacle.
- Children not toilet trained must wear snug-fitting plastic pants.
- Spitting or spouting of water, blowing noses, defecating or urinating in the pool is strictly prohibited.

## **SWIMMING POOL SAFETY**

- Swimming is allowed only when lifeguards are on duty.
- No running or rough playing permitted in pool area or locker room.
- No toys or flotation devices are permitted in the pool except properly fitted USCG approved flotation devices, Type I, II, or III.
- Only one person at a time allowed on diving board, climbing wall and water slide.
- Only feet first sliding on the water slide.
- No swimming in the deep end near the diving board.
- No diving in junior pool or shallow end of the main pool.
- Only lap swimming allowed in the lap lanes.

## **SWIMMING POOL ATTIRE**

- Swimmers must wear clean and appropriate swimwear.
- Cut-off jeans or pants are not authorized.
- Swimming with eyeglasses is permitted if they are safety glasses and properly secured with appropriate straps.

# RESTRICTIONS

- No smoking, glass, or gum permitted anywhere in the pool facility or grounds.
- Alcoholic beverages may be served at private parties in designated areas.
- Portable radios, televisions, or music devices (except small devices equipped with headphones) will not be permitted in the pool area except during private parties.

# AGE GUIDELINES

- Children age 10 and under must be accompanied and under the direct supervision of an individual whose minimum age is 17 years.
- Children age 10 through 17 may be left unattended only if they pass the basic water skills test. Children passing the basic water skills test will be given a green wristband for identification and future access.
- Only children 6 and under allowed in the wading pool.
- Children 3 and under are excluded from the main pool unless under the direct supervision of an individual whose minimum age is 17 years.

## WEATHER POLICY

- At the first sound of thunder or sight of lightning, the pool and deck areas will be cleared of all persons until 30 minutes after the last rumble or sight of lightning.
- If the pool closes due to inclement weather after 4:30 it will not re-open that day.

## WATER QUALITY POLICY

 Pool may be cleared of all persons if chemical balances are not within proper guidelines and will remain cleared until chemical balances have been restored.

## **BREAK PERIOD**

• There will be a 15 minute break period for children every hour.
